Sub: AICTE approval to Indian Institute of Handloom Technology, Guwahati.

Sir,

I am directed to state that on consideration of the recommendations made by the AICTE Task Force for Eastern Region, the All India Council for Technical Education has accorded conditional approval to Indian Institute of Handloom Technology, Guwahati, to conduct Diploma Course in Handloom Technology with an annual intake of 30 (thirty) for the session 1994-95 only.

The approval is subject to fulfilment of the specific and general conditions as under:

Specific Conditions

1. The Institute should be shifted to the new site before admission for 1996-97, at least partially. Till that time, a temporary shed should be constructed with permission from the Govt. of Assam or the training in deficient labs/workshop should be arranged at Assam Textile Institute, Guwahati,
2. The AICTE norms for admission should be followed. Either the Institute should hold the examinations at seven states on the same date or they should admit students from the merit list of the states prepared as per norms of the AICTE for admission to their own Polytechnics (or to the Diploma seats allotted to them by the Govt. of India in case of Jharkhand and Arunachal Pradesh).
3. Examinations should be conducted as suggested by the previous Expert Committee.
4. More equipment should be purchased, particularly for weaving Section and Textile Testing Laboratory. Computer facilities should be provided.
5. The AICTE scales of pay should be given to the faculty.
6. The faculty should be provided as per AICTE norms with prescribed qualifications.
7. Admission for 1995-96 will be decided after evaluation by AICTE.

This approval is subject to fulfillment of specific conditions as enlisted in Annexure-I and general conditions as enlisted in Annexure-II. The Council shall inspect the institution for verification of facilities/compliance of various conditions stipulated in this letter, during November/ December.

The Management/Institute/Trust or Society shall not announce admissions directly under any circumstances and shall lawfully abide by the admission Regulations notified by the AICTE vide GSR 476(E) dated 20.05.1994 based on the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgment dated 14.02.1993 with regard to WP (C) No. 807 of 1992 in the case of Unai Krishnan JP and others etc. V/s. State Government of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and later judgments.

In the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of any of the conditions, guidelines, norms, and regulations prescribed by the AICTE from time to time the AICTE or a body or person(s) authorized by it shall be free to take measures for withdrawal of the approval or recognition without consideration of any related issues and that liabilities arising out of such withdrawal would be solely that of the Management/Trust/Society and/or Institutions. AICTE may also inspect the institution at any time it may deem fit to note progress.

You are requested to kindly take appropriate action to implement the decision of the AICTE and continuously monitor the progress of the institution and communicate it to the North Western Regional Committee of the AICTE under intimation to this office.

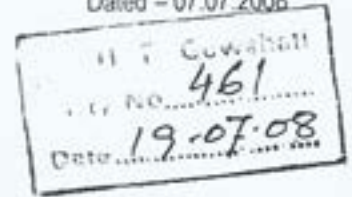

Further, the observation and specific conditions (if any) of the Expert Committee are enclosed in this letter. The Institution shall fulfill all the conditions without any delay. Non-fulfillment shall lead to withdrawal of approval.

The approval accorded above is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

1. All full time faculty members as per AICTE norms must be recruited before making admissions. Admissions shall be made through the Central Counseling by the State/Central Govt. only.
2. All the required Laboratories/Workshops/Machineries/Equipment, as per approved syllabi of the concerned Technical Education Board, must be operational before making admissions.
3. If, this letter of approval is received by you after the closing date of State/National Level Central Counseling for admissions in the concerned State/Union Territory, this letter of approval will not be valid for making any admission during the above specified academic year.
4. No excess admission shall be made by the Institution during any academic year.
5. The approval is valid only for the academic year as mentioned in the above table. If, no further extension of AICTE approval is received beyond the academic year this approval letter will not be valid for making any admission for the subsequent years.
6. Name of the Institution, Name of the Trust/Society is not allowed to change without prior approval of AICTE. The name and title of the Institution should be such that "the emblems and Names (Prevention of improper use) Act (1950)" of Government of India is not violated in any manner.
7. In exercise of power conferred under 10(P) of the AICTE Act, AICTE may inspect the Institution any time it may deem fit to verify the progress/compliance of AICTE norms or for any other purpose.


